Jack Perconte, a Joliet Illinois native, played his high school baseball at Joliet Catholic High School before attending Murray State University in Kentucky. He was drafted in 1976 by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 16th round. Jack played second base in the major leagues off and on between 1980 and 1986 for the Dodgers, Indians, Mariners and White Sox. Jack's career highlights include being a part of the 1981 World Champion Dodgers and tying the then Mariner record of 180 hits in 1984. Jack compiled a .270 lifetime major league batting average. After retiring in 1987 he opened the Jack Perconte's Sports Academy in Naperville, Illinois.

For 25 years Jack Perconte has taught baseball and softball, written numerous books, and coached multiple teams. Jack takes the approach that baseball instruction should be fun for the players and the baseball instructors alike.
